Specifications for submitted ads: All electronic files should be in black and white (grayscale). Supported file types: TIFF, JPG (photos only), PDF, EPS (with fonts converted to outline or paths). For TIFF and JPG, please be careful not to use compression. For PDF, be sure to use "Press-Optimized" settings. Recommended resolution: 300 dpi.
